Bra Bowl Project: DIY Handout

Turn an old bra into a unique paper mache bowl! Fun, quirky, and a great conversation piece.

Materials Needed:

- Old bra (with a band under the cups)
- Medium-thickness cardboard
- Dinner plate (template)
- Masking tape
- Paper mache strips (newspaper + glue mix)
- Paper pulp (optional)
- Sandpaper (fine)
- Paint (emulsion or acrylic)
- Varnish, scissors, pencil, brush

Instructions:

- 1. Cut a cardboard circle the size of your torso (use a dinner plate as a guide).
- 2. Fasten the bra and stretch it over the circle. Tape it securely.
- 3. Cover the bra completely with masking tape; wrap straps well.
- 4. Apply 3 layers of paper mache. Dry upside down to shape straps.
- 5. Add strips underneath to cover tape. Dry thoroughly.
- 6. (Optional) Add pulp to the outside; dry. Then add inside the bra.
- 7. Apply pulp to the inner strap rims. Let dry.
- 8. Turn over and add pulp to strap exteriors.
- 9. Add one more full layer of paper strips.
- 10. Sand lightly. Remove dust.
- 11. Prime with light-coloured paint. Optionally re-coat.
- 12. Paint in your style and varnish.

Tips: Dry upside down, use pulp to sculpt or fix bumps. Be patient!
